

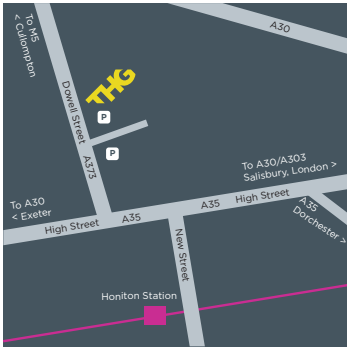

Soil Culture: Young Shoots explores the secret world of soil. Without soil there would be no life. Healthy soils are not only essential for the production of our food, timber and fibres but are a vital part of our global eco-system, filtering our water and acting as a carbon sink to reduce the impact of climate change. That's why the Centre for Contemporary Art and the Natural World (CCANW) commissioned 13 artists to explore it for the United Nations International Year of Soils 2015.

The artists' residencies took place in the South West and London. The resulting exhibition of the artists' fascinating work is now touring the country. It comes to THG following time at Hauser & Wirth, Somerset and the Eden Project, Cornwall.
